Monty, who led the team in scoring, was considered one of the top players in the conference and in this section of the state. Dick Baugher, up from last year's reserves, and the above two are the only graduating members of this year's squad. Other lettermen were Ricky George, Earl Walker, Jim Edwards, Bill Cole, Larry Bouck, Lionel Stirrett, and Larry Grabb.

Individual scoring for the first five was as follows: Nohren, 497 points; George, 371; Bottrell, 276; Baugher, 256; and Walker, 195.

The reserves tasted defeat on only two occasions this year as they roared to a 17 and 2 record. With this material moving up, the Blue Devils will be hard to beat in years to come.
