




The town called Windsor, which was originally Iliopolis but had to be changed because Iliopolis was already a town, was plotted or mapped on May 16, 1856 by Simeon Ruyer and P. C. Huggins. Thanks to these two gentlemen, we have a town to live in and attend school in. The town became a city in 1865 by a special charter. Windsor has grown through the years and at one time had a harness shop, a hotel, and a store called Tom and Bill's. I wonder if it is anything like Jack and Bill's.
